SOUTH GREENLAND

DAY 1 UK – REYKJAVÍK

Scheduled Icelandair flight to Reykjavik. Transfer on arrival to and overnight at Hótel Leifur Eiríksson.

DAY 2 REYKJAVÍK – NARSARSUAQ

Self-transfer to Reykjavik Domestic Airport for flight to Narsarsuaq. Overnight at Hotel Narsarsuaq for four nights.

IGALIKU VILLAGE

A 9-hour tour beginning by boat through an ice filled fjord to Itilleq where you land and continue by foot to the Vikings' Cathedral and Bishops farm ruins. Lunch included.
